

DFI Systems, Inc to move into former Perdue Facility

The Greenville County Board of Supervisors is honored to welcome DFI Systems, Inc. to the former Perdue facility on Hwy 58. DFI Systems, Inc. is an existing manufacturer of wood wall panels and trusses located in Hampton, Virginia. In addition to the products manufactured, the company supplies engineered wood, floor joists, construction hardware, gypsum shaft wall systems and the lumber necessary to complete wood framed construction projects. Projects include supplying materials for single family and multi-family residential structures as well as commercial projects. The company currently employs approximately 60 people.

“We’ve been looking for a way to supply materials to the Raleigh, NC market. After an extensive search we decided that one big facility in the middle of our service area was better than 2 different locations,” company President Marc Gravely stated. He continued, “Greenville County is perfectly situated between our markets of Richmond, Hampton Roads and Raleigh.”

Chairman Astrop of the County Board noted, “The reuse of the former Perdue facility is a win-win for the community. The abandoned building has served as an eye sore for too long. We are excited to work with DFI Systems to rejuvenate the property and bring new employment opportunities to our citizens.”

DFI Systems plans to hire 10-15 people for various positions to start work in March/April of 2021. Some of the types of skills needed are Shop Forklift Operator, CDL Drivers, Truss and Wall Panel Designers, Administrative and Receptionist. In order to fill these positions DFI plans to host a job fair in late February at the new facility. More information will be available closer to that time.
